

Cancellation Policy

- Tour must be cancelled 15 business days prior to the date of the trip to avoid penalty.
- 100% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled the day before/same day the trip.
- 80% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled between 3 and 2 days the trip.
- 70% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled between 6 and 4 days the trip.
- 50% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled between 9 and 7 days the trip.
- 30% penalty of quoted price will be charged when cancelled between 14 and 10 days the trip.

Understanding the Port Guide

- 1. Listed price for each trip is set for up to 18-43 passengers on all trips.

 No partial payment adjustments allowed for less than max number of passengers.
- 2. Payment will be made to **Navy MWR Korea**. MWR pays everything upfront to the tour company. Ship must provide tour dates, number of buses needed and number of passengers for each tour 5-7 days prior to arrival, for reservation of buses/ tour guides.
- 3. If a check is returned for any reason, an administrative fee will be added to the invoice.
- 4. Prices are subject to change by vendor with little or no prior notice.

1. Halla Mountain Climb

Hallasan is the highest mountain in SK with it's peak reaching 1,950m in height. The mountain is a dormant volcano made mostly of basalt. Home to the magnificent Baekrokdam (lake-filled crater), the mountain is characterized by majestic cliffs, steep slopes, and interesting rock formations. Named Korea's Natural Monument No.12 in 1966.

2. Jeju Nature Tour

EcoLand Theme Park and Seojikoji, Udo Island Tour

At EcoLand, in the large Gotjawal forest with railway trails, visitors can see a variety of plants, animals and insects living in the mysterious forests. "Seopji" is the old name for the area, and "Koji" is Jeju dialect meaning a sudden bump on land. Move to Seonsanhang Port for a ferry ride to Udo Island. Udo hosts scenic sights; local heritages like female divers, stone walls, and stone tombs as well as natural attractions abound on the island, making it a miniature of Jeju Island.

3. Jeju Fun + Shopping

Jet around Jeju and see all the hot spots! The Alive Museum, is a cultural playground, with optical illusion art, media art, object Stroll through Jeju Olle Market, the largest market in Seogwipo. Next up is Seongeup Folk Village. Cultural properties in the village have been handed down from generation to generation and include treasures such as residential houses, Confucian shrines and schools, ancient government offices, stone statues, large millstones (pulled by horses or ox), fortress ruins, and stone monuments. Among the cultural gems of the folk village are intangible cultural assets such as folk plays, native foods, local folk craftsmanship, and local dialect. End the day with a thrill, zipline at Daheeyeon.

Seongsan Sunrise Peak

- Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak, 180m above sea level, erupted underwater in the ocean about 5,000 years ago. This makes it a very rare site among the many craters in Jeju Island.
- Seongsan Ilchulbong has long been considered one of the top scenic destinations in Korea. This majestic 182m high tuff volcano shapes like a large pie. Its forested crater has a basin shape with a diameter of about 600m and a depth of 90 m. It attracts millions of visitors a year, many of whom climb to the top for the breathtaking panoramic view of the ocean, Udo Island, Hallasan Mountain, and the volcanic landscape of the east.

Rates:

In Korea rental fee is based on day-by-day, not 24-hour basis. Ex: If you pick up at 23:59 and return it at 01:01= total 2 days.

Individual rentals (Pucks and SIM card) at Pier Vendor

- SIM Card: \$6.00 (1-day), \$15 (3-days), \$23 (5-days)
- Wi-Fi Puck (connect up to 3 devices): \$4.00 (1-day)
 - \$100 Wi-Fi puck deposit is automatically charged with payment.

Group rental: Pick-up & Return Service (pucks only)

- Wi-Fi Puck (connect up to 3 devices): \$4.50 (1-day) per device
 - No deposit hold; however POC will be charged \$100.00 for each Wi-Fi Puck not returned.
